

26. The Oga, Akita, Earthquake, 1939



(May 1st, 14:58 40°00'N, 139°48'E, $r=400$ km, $M=6.6$)

Damage total: 27 dead, 52 injured, 479 completely, 858 half destroyed houses, 106 completely, 156 half destroyed huts, 11 burnt houses. A slight tsunami occurred due to a land deformation of considerable scale near the origin. At Tsuchizaki Harbour, the tsunami of 27 cm in double amplitude was observed.
