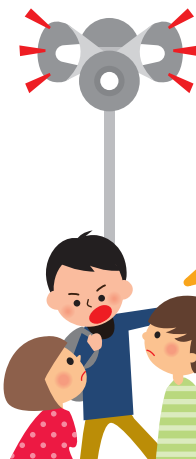

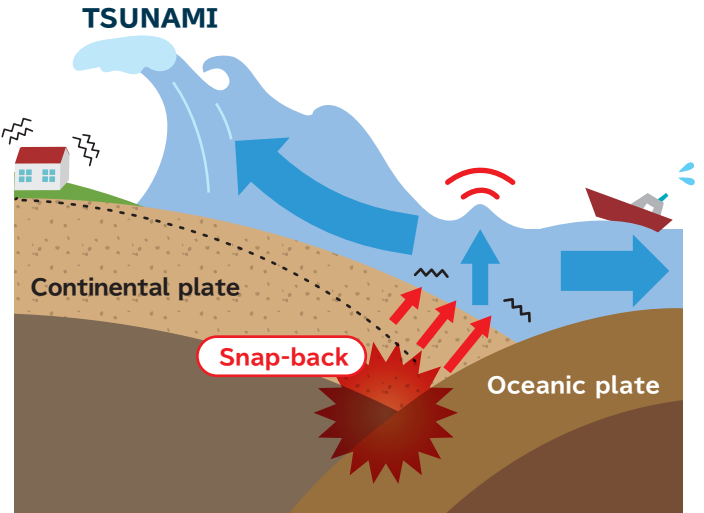
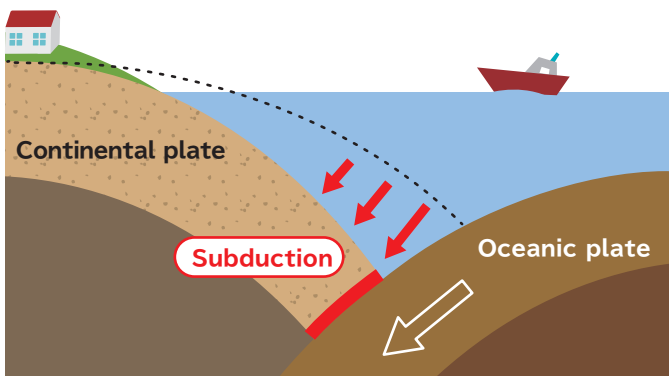
Mechanics of earthquakes and tsunami

Shallow crustal earthquake

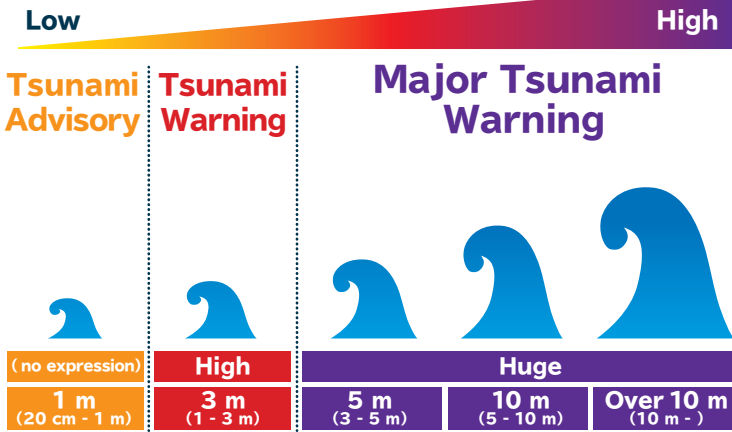


Interplate earthquake

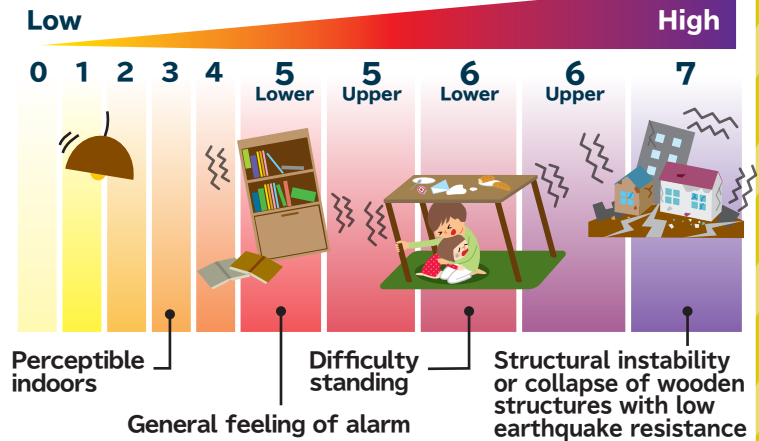

Japanese seismic intensity scale

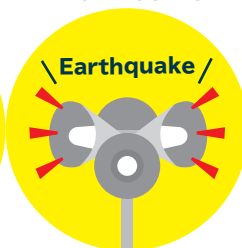
