Himawari-8 enters geostationary orbit

The next-generation geostationary meteorological satellite of the Japan Meteorological Agency, Himawari-8, entered geostationary orbit on 16 October 2014 as planned.

The satellite is expected to start operation in mid-2015 after the completion of in-orbit testing and checking of the overall system including related ground facilities.
